

12. Vote to approve or disapprove student fundraisers for 2010-2011.
13. Vote to approve or disapprove loan agreement for food service deficits.
(This allows the general fund to recover expended funds from the child nutrition fund if the child nutrition fund has the funds at the end of the year.)
14. Open milk bids for 2010-2011. Vote to approve or not approve the lowest and/or best bid for the 2010-2011 school term.
15. Vote to approve resolution to affirm commitment to Navajo Public Schools Hazard Mitigation Plan.
16. Vote to approve or not approve for the 2010-2011 school year. pursuant to HB 1864, a school year which shall consist of not less than one thousand eighty (1,080) hours of classroom instruction. Not more than thirty (30) of the one thousand eighty (1080) hours shall be used for professional meetings. In addition, parent/teacher conferences may be held during the school day and counted as classroom instruction for no more than six (6) of hours per semester, for a total of twelve (12) of the one thousand eighty (1.080) hours per school year.
